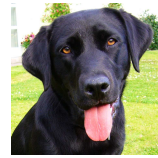




Advice from The Frinton Residents' Association



The Tendring District Council (TDC) is actively supporting the use of its dog friendly beaches and details can be found on their website (www.tendringdc.gov.uk). To help dog walkers in Frinton-on-Sea, we are supplementing this advice with some specific detail which we hope you find useful.

There is a defined area of our beach which has “Dog Free” conditions that apply from 1st May to 30th September; details can be found on the sketch overleaf. The “Dog Free” restrictions can be enforced by TDC. The maximum penalty for contravention of this byelaw is £500 and this also applies to dogs not being on leads on the promenade behind these beaches.

There are people who have had bad experiences with dogs and many others, including children, who do not want to be bothered by dogs whilst they are enjoying the beach at any time of the day during the summer.

Please allow them to do so.

Outside the area specified overleaf, the beach is “Dog Friendly” so can be used by dog walkers all year round.

Your kind consideration for others will be much appreciated and we hope you enjoy our Town by the Sea.
